

LOGIC MODEL ACCOUNTABILITY FRAMEWORK

*Logic Model	The PPO supports the use of a 'logic model' as the accountability framework for practice councils. Logic models are diagrams or flow sheets that show the relationships between the outcomes a group is expected to meet and what the group does (roles, inputs, activities, outputs) to achieve those outcomes. A logic model is a tool for planning, setting priorities, communicating and for identifying indicators of success.
Logic Model Components	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Inputs - resources to accomplish work▪ Activities - strategies/actions to achieve purpose and outcomes (short & long term)▪ Outputs - the direct products of strategies/actions▪ Outcomes - benefits resulting from activities and outputs
